GENERAL INFORMATION

Border AREA! Kindly note that you are on the border of two countries of the European Union (Germany and Poland), which are separated only by a bridge. Please note that in each country a different language is spoken and has has a different currency. Due to possible border controls, please always carry your passport and visa with you, when crossing the bridge.

The official **currency** in Germany is Euro (**EUR**), and in Poland it is the Polish Złoty (**PLN**), 1 EUR = 4.6 PLN. **Credit cards** are widely accepted, but it's advisable to carry some cash. You can **exchange the currency** in numerous exchange offices near the Polish border. Prices are similar in both countries.

Frankfurt and Slubice are cities where it is best to get around **on foot**. The buildings where the sessions will be held, as well as the hotels, are located in close proximity, making it easiest to **move between them on foot**. The map shows the most important locations. All venues (excepting Sunday) are held in Germany on the main campus.

Public transport is available in Frankfurt (bus, tram), but you can also use local **taxis** if necessary (Tel. +49335531111). No UBER available. Both cities are relatively safe.

The sockets in Europe have the designation ${}_{\!_{\!4}}$, Type C" and are powered by 230 V.


